









Packing Screens Into Your Stem

There are many ways to get your screens ready for your crack stem. Below is just one way. OHRDP gives out screens in a pack of five. You may find you need more or less than five. Play around with it until you find a way that's right for you. When packing screens, make sure to pack them tight enough so they don't fall out, but loose enough for air flow.

	<p>Step 1</p> <p>Wash your hands and your work space, or wipe them with alcohol swabs.</p> <p>Remove all 5 screens from the pack.</p>
	<p>Step 2</p> <p>Stack all 5 screens together.</p> <p>Use your thumb to fold in one side of the screens.</p>
	<p>Step 3</p> <p>Use your thumb to fold in the other side so that your stack of screens looks like this.</p>
	<p>Step 4</p> <p>Roll screens into the middle with the folded sides in.</p> <p>It should look like a cone.</p>

	<p><i>Step 5</i></p> <p>Press together tightly.</p>
	<p><i>Step 6</i></p> <p>Insert screens into the stem.</p>
	<p><i>Step 7</i></p> <p>Place the stem on your clean work space and push the screens down with the push stick.</p>
	<p><i>Step 8</i></p> <p>Push the screens about 1cm into the stem to allow room for the crack rock.</p>
