

OVERDOSE PREVENTION

Naloxone can save a life

In Ontario, between 300 to 400 people die every year from overdose involving prescription opioids- most commonly oxycodone.

Do your clients use opioids like OxyContin, OxyNeo, heroin, Hydromorphone, Fentanyl, Dilaudid?

- **If so, they are at risk of overdose**

What can you do?

- Ask about staff training on opioid overdose prevention and Naloxone so that you can educate clients and help make overdose prevention kits available at your program site.
